Background

1 in 10 newborns need help breathing after birth. Helping Babies Breathe is an internationally recognized program aimed to reduce infant mortality by providing life-saving measures with the first minute of birth – the “Golden Minute.” A birth attendant trained in Helping Babies Breathe should be available to provide life-saving care for every birth.

Objectives

Helping Babies Breathe is a course that provides education and skills for birth attendants to attend to key aspects of care within the first minutes of life, including:

- Identification of a newborn in danger
- Administration of life-saving measures

Other essential newborn care considerations are also taught.
